## RECONSTITUTED STONE

### **Maintenance**

#### **Surface Wear**

**Prevention** Choose stone finish as honed, sandblasted etc. in areas

susceptible to damage.

**Protection** Regular use of liquid waxes, added in small quantities to

the water used for washing. Acrylic waxes, which are applied by machine, are less commonly used and form a

robust protective layer.

**Restoration** Marble based products can be reground to restore their

original finish.

**Surface Scratching** 

**Prevention** Adequate prevention of outside debris entering building.

Use of lighter colours and less uniform patterns in

critical areas.

**Protection** Apply acrylic waxes to forma protective layer.

**Restoration** Quartz based products can be reground to restore their

original appearance. Liquid type waxes render scratches much less visible and therefore reduce their negative

impact.

**Chemical Damage** 

**Prevention** Use neutral pH detergents. Remove any acidic or

alkaline substances immediately if they come into

contact with the surface.

**Protection** Quartz based composites do not require any form of

protection due to technically advanced resilliance.

**Restoration** Re-polishing restores the completely to its original finish.

The application of paste type waxes reduces the

visibility of any signs of damage.

### **Maintenance**

# **Dirt/Dust Build Up**

**Prevention** Avoid using light colours and uniform patterns in critical

areas. Avoid low polished finishes with very light colours. Clean regularly with clear water and a neutral

detergent.

**Protection** The addition of small amounts of liquid wax to the

washing water prevents dust build-up, facilitating cleaning and ensuring that the original shine is

maintained.

**Restoration** Re-polishing the surface restores the stone completely

to its original appearance.

## **Heat Damage**

**Prevention** Avoid contact with very hot pots and pans as excessive

localised heat can damage the surface.

**Protection** Use heat insulated mats or stands to protect the surface

from cooking utensils like electric fry pans, kettles and

woks.

**Restoration** Re-polishing the surface restores the stone completely

to its original appearance.
